

# Activities

The Activities page asks you to report on the major categories of service activities conducted under your Learn and Serve grant and to indicate some of the more common specific activities.

  - Youth Development
- Bottom Callout:** The **total percentage across all categories must equal 100%**. If you do not have any activities in a category, leave the percentage box blank.
- Right Callout:** You can then identify up to 3 of the most common activities conducted by your program in each category.
- Bottom Callout:** The bottom of the Activities page also includes several questions about **Disaster Preparedness and Response** programs. If you do not conduct disaster-related service programs, you can leave those items blank.
